AMENDMENT TO ALLEGAN TOWNSHIP ZONING ORDINANCE

ORDINANCE NO. 06-01

An ordinance to amend the Allegan Township Zoning Ordinance Chapter XII to add Sections 12.32 and 12.33 to limit the number of dogs and cats allowed in residentially zoned areas and to regulate fences; and to repeal all parts of ordinances in conflict herewith and to provide for an effective date of said ordinance.

SECTION I

AMENDMENT TO CHAPTER XII, GENERAL PROVISIONS

The Allegan Township Zoning Ordinance is hereby amended by the addition of a new Section 12.32, "Limitation of Dogs and Cats." The new section will read as follows:

Section 12.32. Limitation of Dogs and Cats.

It shall be unlawful for any person to own, possess, shelter, keep, or harbor any combination of dogs or cats over four (4) months of age at any one time, not to exceed three in residentially zoned areas. The provisions of this section do not apply to animals owned by a licensed research facility or held in a veterinary medical facility or government operated or licensed animal protection shelter or licensed kennel/cattery facility.
