

## Rules and Regulations

- Unused urns will be removed.
- No statues, or statues that are used as urns, are allowed.
- Permanent plants, urns, flowers and decorations are to be placed in line with the headstone (not in front or in back).
- Urns will be emptied, and artificial flowers removed after October 1<sup>st</sup>. U.S. flags removed immediately after Veteran's Day.



- All flowers are individuals' responsibilities. Unkept flowers will be removed.

- Any planting can be removed at decision of township authority.
- One solar light is permitted.
- Footers are to be placed by Sexton only.
- No grading, leveling, or excavating upon burial space shall be allowed without the permission of the Cemetery Sexton or the Township Clerk.
- No flowers, shrubs, trees or vegetation of any type shall be planted without the approval of the Township Clerk. Any of the foregoing items planted without such approval may be removed by the Township.
- The Township reserves the right to remove or trim any tree, plant or shrub located within the cemetery in the interest of maintaining proper appearance and the use of the cemetery.

- The Township shall have the right to remove and dispose of any and all growth, emblems, displays or containers therefore that through decay, deterioration, damage or otherwise become unsightly, a source of litter or a maintenance problem.
- Surfaces other than earth or sod are prohibited.



- All refuse of any kind or nature including, among others, dried flowers, wreaths, papers and flower containers must be removed or deposited in containers located within the cemetery.

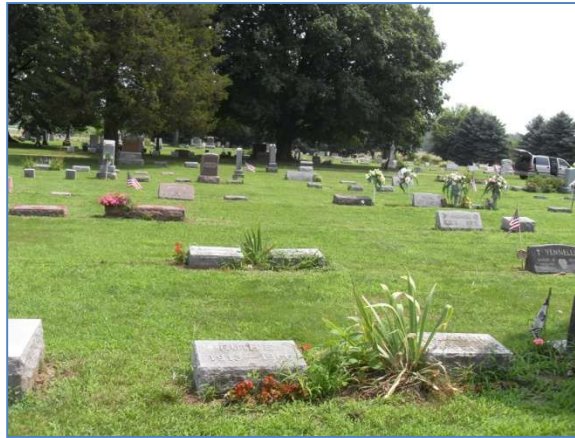
\*Additional \$100.00/hour after 4 PM

Burials per grave may include one body, two sets of cremains, or one body and

one set of cremains. Only one headstone allowed per grave, which shall not exceed 40" long.

A resident is defined as a person living in the Township, either owning or renting a dwelling unit, or a person who resided in the Township at the date of death. This shall also include a person who lived in the Township, but, due to health reasons, has moved outside the Township.
